Procedures

The Greater Detroit Old Timers Bowling Association has established a program to further interest in youth bowling, foster a desire for better education for our youth, give the youth bowlers incentive to maintain their amateur status and to help enhance the image of the sport.

Two or more scholarships

- (a) Two or more graduating seniors will be granted a scholarship each year.
- (b) The scholarships will be for \$ 750.00
- (c) Each student will have a certificate to show that he/she has been awarded the scholarship, the scholarship will be paid out to the SMART system and will be accessed by the student for payout to the school
- (d) The recipient must request the funds within four (4) years of graduation. If they do not, they forfeit the scholarship. Interest will not be accrued.

Eligibility and procedures to apply

- (a) Any organized youth league member in good standing.
- (b) Graduating male or female high school senior.
- (c) Individuals must contact their coach or the Greater Detroit Oldtimers Bowling Association, 52719 Ellsworth Way, Macomb, Mi. 48042 to request applications forms by mail or email, they can also be accessed on the MHSAA website. They will be sent along with an explanation for completion.

Board of Trustees

- (a) The board of directors of the Greater Detroit Old Timers Bowling Association will serve as the board of trustees.
- (b) The Scholarship Fund Committee will review applicants and make the decision and selection.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANT

ELIGIBILITY RULES:

Any graduating male or female high school senior is eligible to receive a scholarship, providing the student meets the following requirements:

- (A) Files an application furnished by the Scholarship Fund Committee, giving complete information as required thereon, before July 15th of the applicable year.
- (B) Is a member in good standing of any high school bowling team, or any organized Junior Program, or other organized bowling league.

Application Procedure:

Step 1 - Fill out the entire application.

Step 2- Write an essay of at least 100 words stating your career goals and academic goals and future plans.

Step 3- Give the school Official/Counselor's Evaluation Sheet to your school Counselor or Official for completion along with a stamped envelope addressed to Greater Detroit Oldtimers Bowling Association 52719 Ellsworth Way, Macomb, Mi., 48042

Step 4- Check with your league coach and/or Counselor by July 15th to make sure all application papers have been submitted. Thank them for their help and co-operation.

Step 5- Submit your application, essay, and all other items to the address above by July 15th.
